

Tuition fees for entry 2018



The tuition fees are for the listed academic year and subsequent years of study whether full or part-time will be charged at the rate for that academic year except where indicated. For regulated Home/EU undergraduate fees, the School will charge the maximum fee permitted by the government for that year. All other fee levels are set by the School's Board of Governors at least a year in advance and may reflect the inflation rate at the time of approval and any significant changes in the cost of delivery (eg utility costs) where relevant. You should budget for a minimum annual increase of 2% to 3%. Where a significant increase above the inflation rate is determined for new entrants, transitional fees may apply for continuing students.

Home/EU ELQ students starting a new programme of study, including direct entrants, pay the Non-EU rate (except Advanced Certificate and Artist Diploma).

A non-refundable 15% deposit is required of tuition fees due by 15th July 2018. However, undergraduate Home/EU students eligible for a student tuition fee loan are exempt.
