At Guildhall School we award places on the basis of talent, regardless of financial circumstances. We know how life changing it can be for a student to be given the opportunity to pursue their dreams. Each year nearly half of our students receive scholarship support from generous donors and from the School's own income generating activity. Many more need vital funds to enable them to take up their hard won places and continue their years of training.

Training as a young artist has never been more expensive. On average, students graduate from university with £40,000 of student loan debt, and this amount is far greater for overseas students. The intensity of conservatoire training, and the significant additional practice and performance hours required, prevent students from funding their studies with concurrent paid employment. Philanthropic support is therefore integral to continuing to provide world-class training to all talented students.




